I. CALRE

The Conference of Regional Legislative Assemblies of the European Union, CALRE, brings together the regional parliaments with legislative powers of 74 European regions of Italy, Spain, Belgium, Germany, United Kingdom (Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland), Portugal (Azores and Madeira) and Finland.

Since its creation in Oviedo in 1997, CALRE's mission has been to deepen the democratic and participatory principles within the framework of the European Union, defend the values and principles of regional democracy and strengthen ties between the regional legislative Assemblies.

CALRE ensures respect for the principle of subsidiarity and its consolidation in the European Union; works to strengthen relationships with other European organizations, as well as to increase and improve the relations with the European Parliament.

CALRE contributes to the democratic participation of the regional Assemblies within the framework of the European Union and strengthens the relations between regional Assemblies, in particular through the exchange of good practices, fully respecting the independence of each Assembly.



II. CALRE WORKING GROUPS

The CALRE Working Groups are subsidiary bodies that deal with very different matters proposed in the General Assembly that annually celebrates CALRE.

There are currently 11 working groups (cohesion, depopulation, gender equality, migration policies, etc.). The current year 2020, Alberto Castillo Baños, President of the Regional Assembly of Murcia, was elected coordinator of the working group "Natural Catastrophes", also integrated by the regional parliaments of Belgium, Spain, Italy and Portugal.

With the aim of fighting any natural catastrophe, the role of the European Regional Legislative Assemblies must be focused on drafting policies in order to fight the climate change and more control over all those policies that do not fulfill this goal.

Regional parliaments must urge governments to define those infrastructures that should be reinforced as a preventive measure and promote educational and awareness policies about the main preservation of the earth.
